The Appropriation Act, 2025

Short title.

Being an Act to authorise expenditure from the Consolidated Fund for the services of Sierra Leone for the year 2025 and for other related matters.

ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled.

] Date of commencement.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of sums of money necessary to meet the expenditure to carry on the services of the Government.

- Commencement. 1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2025.

The sum of twenty seven billion seven hundred and sixteen million three hundred and fifty seven thousand four hundred Leones shall be and is hereby granted to His Excellency the President for and during the year two thousand and twenty five to be applied and expended in the manner described and for the several services set forth in the Schedule.

Charged on
revenue. 3. The sum of twenty seven billion seven hundred and sixteen million three hundred and fifty seven thousand four hundred Leones referred to in section 2, shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the year two thousand and twenty five and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin on and immediately after the first day of January, two thousand and twenty five.

authority for
payment. 4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required to pay out of the Consolidated Fund for the several services specified in the Schedule, such sums as may be specified in the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance, issued from time to time up to the sum of twenty seven billion seven hundred and sixteen million three hundred and fifty seven thousand four hundred Leones which shall come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, two thousand and twenty five.

Expenditure. 5. The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorised in section 4 shall not exceed in the gross the sum of twenty seven billion seven hundred and sixteen million three hundred and fifty seven thousand four hundred Leones from the first day of January, two thousand and twenty five inclusive, and any balances remaining unissued at the end of December, two thousand and twenty five shall lapse and not be available for making any payment in the following year.
